As of this writing (end of January), we only need masks on in church when singing or when social distancing is not possible. I thank people for their increasing willingness to embrace these requirements. Special thanks to Margaret Lister-Brown, Evelyn Cunningham and Robyn Keath who have fulfilled our roles as Covid Safe Wardens, and our covid cleaning before and after services, both new requirements. We continue to need to record attendance and contact details.

Worship Services at St Andrew's

We have now returned to two weekly Sunday services (9 am and 11am) and a prerecorded service. The prerecorded service is available on DVD and the Church web site www.kyabramanglican.org.au. On the web site is also the readings for the Sunday and any announcements for that week.

We also have a weekly Wednesday service where we celebrate Holy Communion each week. The Wednesday service does not have any singing, so masks are not required under current requirements.

Recently our recorded services and the Wednesday service provided some options for people instead of coming out in the heat of the previous week.

The "Freedom In Christ" course starts this week.

Ministry to the congregation at Tongala is also ongoing and has been primarily through recorded services and delivery of DVD's. We are yet to resume services at St James' but we hope they will recommence shortly.

All the Clergy of the Diocese are meeting with Bishop Matt on Tuesday 2nd February to talk about the Change or Suppression (Conversion) Practices Prohibition Bill 2020. This bill has passed the lower house of our state parliament and will be introduced into the upper house in the coming months. Your prayer is greatly appreciated.

I hope to receive an update from Bishop Matt shortly on the sharing of tea and coffee after services but also Shrove Tuesday pancakes at Tongala. There continues to be a great deal of complexity on the safe implementation of current covid requirements.
